



OAC Ministries Working Abroad Policy

Approved by the Trustees 18th October 2018 Reviewed bi-annually

Policy review date 8th October 2024 (updates in yellow)

Each evangelist and volunteer is responsible for the arrangement of travel insurance for themselves or as a member of a group travel insurance arrangement.

Each evangelist and volunteer is responsible for obtaining and following medical advice regarding immunisation etc.

Evangelists will not be covered by OAC's Insurance Policy if travelling to countries against the advice of UK Government ([follow the link for details - ForeignTravelAdvice](#))

Evangelists and volunteers must adhere to any quarantine or other government regulations relating to any **diseases** both in the countries where they are ministering and upon return to the UK.

Evangelists should complete **their own specific written risk assessment** for themselves and other team members prior to the mission trip. (A standard risk assessment template for overseas mission (RA5) is available for adaptation from the General Secretary upon request).

The **OAC Safeguarding policy** will apply to trips overseas and should be complied with.

The OAC policy does not cover evangelists and volunteers for any **manual work** i.e. building and allied trades, nor does it cover any medical or nursing work.

Failure to comply with the above may invalidate any claims against OAC Insurance Policy.
